



Installation


IMPORTANT: Before drilling, always check for pipes and cables

This product has adjustable end brackets, this means they can be set at your preferred distance apart and can also assist in covering existing screw holes. These will be fixed once secured to the wall.

1. Remove the caps from the front of each end bracket before installing, taking care not to damage the surface.




2. Position the end brackets against the wall in the desired location and mark the drill holes through the end brackets. Check that the holes are aligned using a spirit level.



Please note: Ensure that the brackets are not positioned at the very ends of the rail as the retaining screw must have sufficient rail surface to be secured against


Please note: Ensure that the location of the slider when at its highest point will not put the hose under tension

3. Remove the brackets and drill the wall in the marked positions, then Insert the wall plugs and tap flat to finish the wall surface.




Please note: When drilling, it is recommended to place masking tape over the mark to prevent the drill from slipping

4. Hold the bottom end bracket to the wall and secure into position, using the screw provided. Repeat for the top end bracket.




5. Push the rail through the bottom end bracket from underneath, so that the end sits between the two end brackets, then place the slider bracket onto the rail. Once the slider is fitted, push the end of the rail through the top end bracket and centralize the rail.




Please note: Ensure that the larger of the openings for the hand shower is facing upwards and that you can press the button to move the slider on the rail

6. Once the rail location is set, from the front of the end bracket, insert the plastic retaining screw with the rubber pad into the bracket, with the pad facing the rail. Tighten the screw onto the rail so that it grips and holds the rail in location. Carry out the same process for the other end bracket.



7. Finally, fit the caps back onto both ends of the brackets.



IMPORTANT: During use, do not move the slider on the rail without pressing the button or turning the lever to loosen as this will damage the slider bracket over time

Cleaning

To maintain the surface finish of your product, wipe clean after every use, using a clean damp cloth, a mild detergent mixture can be used. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials on the product surface.

If any harsh chemicals come into contact with the surface of the product during bathroom cleaning, rinse off immediately, wipe clean and dry.

If the hand shower should become blocked over a period of time, simply rub your finger over the rubber nozzles to break any build up. Do not shower immediately, run the shower for approximately 20 seconds to flush through any debris.
