Receive Your Kitchen Sink

Unpack and check for damage.

Unpack it and check for any damage.

Upon receiving your sink, unpack it and remove all packaging, checking for any damage. If the sink is not to be installed immediately, repack it.

Any claims for damage will be rejected if not reported in a timely manner.

Protect your sink.

Before starting installation, make sure that the sink is completely protected and leave the packaging in place until the work in the kitchen is completed. Scratches and damage caused during installation are not covered by the warranty.

Installation

Sinks must be installed according to this instruction manual. Manufacturer is not held responsible for any defects resulting from lack of observance of these instructions.

In case of detecting transport defects or any other shortages or damages, immediately report them to Seller.

Until the complained is examined, sink must be kept in original package.

Note:

Do not put the sink on its side edge because this may lead to sink damage! Do not stack objects on the sink!

Pay particular attention during installation because there is a danger of crushing your fingers when inserting the sink into hole cut in a worktop.

I.Preparing a hole in a worktop.

- 1. After preparation of a worktop and determining the place of sink installation, apply template to the worktop and fix it with a tape to preclude its movement.
- 2. Using a soft pencil, outline the template.
- 3. Remove the template.
- 4.Cut the outlined worktop section guiding the jigsaw along the inside contour of the template.

II.Placing the sink in the prepared hole

- 1. Check the position of fixing clamps. Put the loose clamps in the cut-outs on the bottom of the sink.
- 2. Apply silicone on the bottom part of the sink edge.
- 3.Insert the sink into the prepared hole, paying attention to correct position of bowls and dish drainer.
- 4. Screw the clamps to worktop using a screwdriver. Clamps should be screwed on the sink in alternating fashion (clamps are only immobilizing elements not installation elements).


III.Installation of waste and taps


- 1.Make sure that the selected tap provides tightness between the sink tap and the sink during normal installation.
- 2. Tap must be installed in the sink according to enclosed instruction manual.
- 3.Install a waste according to separate installation manual. Waste bag includes all necessary gaskets.
- 4. Pipes can be shortened according to needs.




Do not overtighten the syphon outflow and automatic sink plug. Tensioning can lead to sink cracks. Complaint shall not be recognized.















*** Do not use the kitchen sink within 24 hours to let the silicone fully cure

Operation and maintenance of granite sinks

Sink is designed for use in households. In order to maintain the sink in perfect aesthetic and technical condition, do not use the sink so that it is endangered to mechanical, technical or chemical defects and use it according to its purpose.

- 1.Clean the sink with kitchenware detergent or clean water with mild cleaning agents, e.g. food vinegar.
- 2. Avoid any lacquers, nails remover, solvents, fired cigarettes, etc. to contact the sink surface.
- 3.Do not put colouring agents on the sink (coffee, tea, vegetable juice) that might cause tarnish which is difficult to remove.
- 4.Difficult contamination must be removed with washing cream. After washing, flush with water and apply thin layer of food oil.
- 5. Periodically clean the outflows and syphon using commonly used agents, according to manufacturer's recommendations.
- 6.If the water is hard, do not let permanent lime sediments to form on the surface. Scale can be removed using thinned vinegar or commonly available cleaning agents.
- 7. Throwing flatware or other hard objects into the sink may cause damage in some instances.

The above waste packs are included with your sink.

Some small components (Plug Peg - Underside and Waste Retaining Screw) within the waste pack supplied with this sink are produced using brass alloys which contain trace amounts of lead for production.

The main body of the sink does not contain any trace amounts of lead.

Lead is included on the EU and UK REACH Candidate Lists for Substances of Very High Concern, when at levels above 0.1% w/w. The components and levels of lead will not cause issue during normal kitchen use and are accepted for use in brass alloys.

Some guidelines and advice are applicable:

Not intended for direct handling by young children

Wash hands after installation.

Dispose of responsibly at end of life in accordance with Local Waste Regulations

During normal use there is no direct contact with food stuffs or water in the sink.
