


- 1 Place the TV with the front panel facing downwards on the soft cloth or soft pads on a desk.

- 3 Insert the screws into the sockets and tighten them.




1.5 Installation of Batteries

(Here is only the sketch, please in kind prevail)





- ② Install two 7#(AAA)1.5V batteries. Ensure the correct polarity of the batteries.
- 3 Cover the back lid. Please take out of the batteries from the remote control for long time of no use.



- Check the TV is turned on.
- Check the polarity of the batteries are correct.
- Check the batteries are not drained.
- Check the power supply is normal or the power cord is correctly connected.
- Check there are no special fluorescent light or neon light around.



2. Basic Operation

2.1 Power ON/OFF(Optional)

- Connect the power cord to the **AC input**. Insert the power cord into the appropriate socket.
- Press the **Power switch** to switch on the TV, then press**Power** button to turn on the unit.
- Press the **Power switch** again to switch off the TV.

Note: After switch off the TV, please don't immediately re-open the power switch ,should be delayed one minute more to re-open the power switch.

2.2 Setting of Standby Mode

- Press (\circlearrowleft) button to turn on the unit.
- Be sure not to set your TV in standby mode for a long period of time.


2.3.Source

Press <SOURCE > to display the source menu.

Press ▲ / ▼to select the corresponding input channel, and then press <ENTER > to confirm.

2.4.TV Menu

Picture Setup





Press <Menu> to display the main menu, then press ◀ / ► to select the Picture, press ▼ / to select The corresponding option, press <Menu> to return or press <Exit> to exit the menu.

Picture mode: including standard, soft, user, game, vivid, natural, sports, lightness eight modes, where the user mode can customize the brightness, contrast, chroma, hue and sharpness and other effects parameters.

Color Temperature: used to set the color temperature you feel comfortable.

Aspect Ratio: used to select the viewer's favorite picture scale viewing mode.

Noise Reduction: used to reduce noise to improve picture quality.

MPEG NR: used to smooth the video screen to reduce noise to improve image quality.

Sound Setup





Press <Menu> to display the main menu, then press ◀ / ► to select the Sound, press ▼ / ▲ to select the corresponding option, press <Menu> to return or press <Exit> to exit the menu.

Sound Mode: Select the sound mode, when set to user mode, the user can according to their favorite bass and treble to adjust.

EQ settings: Click the eq setting to enter the submenu to adjust the gain of the corresponding frequency sound, the adjustment range is 0-100.

Balance: adjust the speaker sound output balance, adjust the range of 0-100.

Auto Volume: Turn on / off the automatic volume control, when the volume exceeds the set value, will automatically reduce the volume amplitude, protect the amplifier.

AD Switch: designed for people with visual impairment, you can make up for the lack of visual impairment through the sound, open the AD volume can also be adjusted.

Hearing Impaired: designed for people with hearing impaired, open will mark whether to speak for the narration, will raise this is the sound of water, open the door, laughter, and so on.

Surround: Select the surround sound mode (off / on).

SPDIF Mode: Select Coaxial Output Mode.

Channel setup



Press <Menu> to display the main menu, then press ◀ / ► to select the channel, press ▼ / ▲ to select the corresponding option, press <Menu> to return or press <Exit> to exit the menu.

Antenna Type: (Air/Cable).

5. Simple Troubleshooting

If the display fails or the performance changes dramatically, check the display in accordance with the following instructions. Remember to check the peripherals to pinpoint the source of the failure.

Power cannot be turned on. (Power indicator does not light.)	-Check that both ends of the power cable are plugged into the socket appropriately and the wall socket is operational
No Input Signal message appears.	 -Check that the signal line is connected properly. -Check that the power of the relevant peripherals is turned on. -Check that the Input option that has been selected matches with the input signal.
The remote control does not function properly.	 -Check the batteries are not drained. (Use new batteries.) -Check that the remote control is within the operating range. -Check that the remote control is pointed to the remote control window on the display. -Check that there are no obstacles between the remote control and the remote control window.
Flashing spots or stripes appear on the screen.	-Check that there are no emission (Car, HV cable or Neon lamp) or other possible interference sources.
Image colour or quality deteriorates.	 -Check that all the video settings are adjusted appropriately, such as brightness, contrast, colour etc. -For more information about video settings, refer to OSD Functions in Chapter 2.
Screen position and size are incorrect.	-Check that the screen position and size is adjusted appropriately.
